West Sacramento 4th Annual Juneteenth Celebration June 12, 2026

On June 12, 2026, Chasten Gold Nonprofit participated in the City of West Sacramento's 4th Annual Juneteenth Celebration as part of its Technical Assistance Grant community outreach initiative. The celebration brought together over 1,000 families from across the region to recognize culture, history, and community, while providing an excellent opportunity to integrate environmental education into a trusted community event.

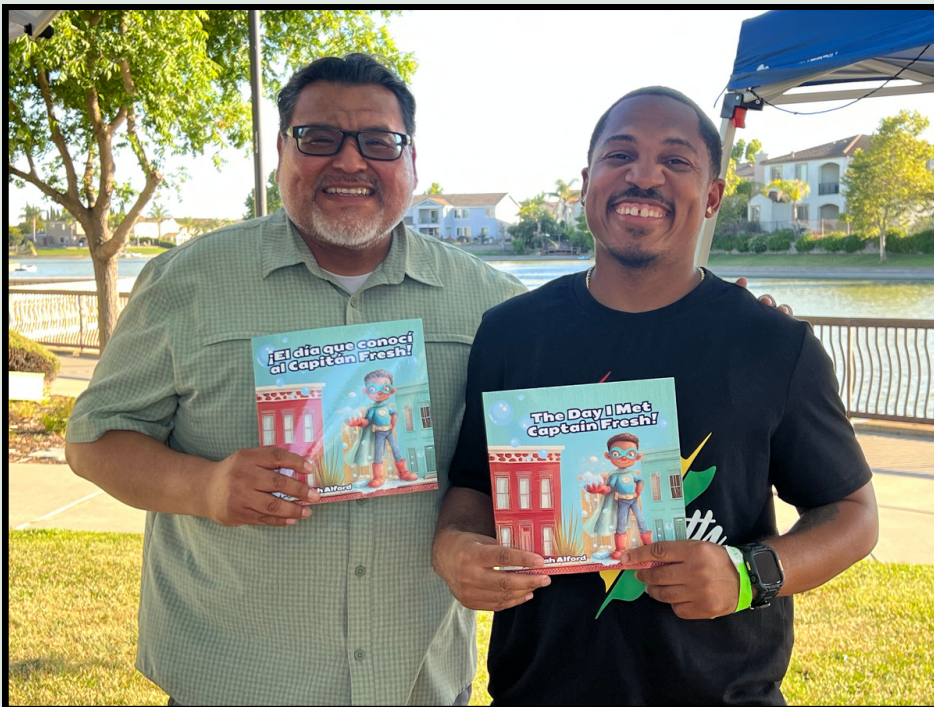
The Chasten Gold booth featured the popular interactive contaminated-soil experiment, allowing children to search for hidden toys in simulated contaminated soil while learning that harmful substances are not always visible. The activity naturally led into discussions about handwashing, safe outdoor play, and ways families can reduce exposure to environmental contaminants.

50 children and families also received complimentary educational giveaways, environmental health materials, and copies of *The Day I Met Captain Fresh!* Staff and our on-site Spanish Translator answered questions regarding local environmental issues and explained the importance of community involvement throughout contaminated site cleanup efforts. The event successfully expanded awareness among residents who may not otherwise participate in traditional environmental meetings while creating positive community relationships through engaging educational activities.
